8. Question session

Dagnė Kvietkutė, chairperson of VGTU SR CIF, answers questions regarding the VGTU SR CIF activity report for the period from March 24, 2025, to October 14, 2025.

Gabrielė Nareckaitė KIF-22/1: I wanted to ask about the discussion of the final thesis in the surveys. Could the representatives come and listen to how everything is being reviewed, or will the information be communicated in another way?

Answer: The fact is that I am finishing my term and the dean and I have agreed that we will do the whole process ourselves. This can still be discussed and consulted on, but we will confidently be passing the information.

Miglė Česonytė PKF-22/2: What difficulties did you encounter as chairperson?

Answer: There is nothing specific that I would single out. There were ups and downs, there were arguments that made it difficult to get out of bed. However, overall, I am very happy that we managed to maintain an active team during this term. I am glad that we have wonderful first-year students who were active and hard-working. It's not anything specific, there was everything, everything happens.



Saulius Paukštė (guest, TSRV): Why do you think there are no international students here? And what is the relationship with the representatives of international student academic groups?

Answer: It was written that most have already been elected. This should be verified, but I believe that this inclusion should be implemented, as we are the representative body of all students and are capable of doing so. If here were even one international student, I would not be standing here and certainly would not be conducting the conference in Lithuanian; there would be someone to translate everything. At the moment, there is not much demand for this, and we are not ready to accept them. If there were more of them, it would be different. Letters were sent to them, but none of them came.

Saulius Paukštė (guest, TSRV): Should alumni be invited to events/collaborate during the term of office, or should they join?

Answer: Human resources coordinators contributed from time to time. I have two alumni in my team, one of whom was the chair and appeared regularly and contributed: the last time I remember was the first meeting of curators with x groups. Separately, then together.

Adding to the question: Were separate recommendations made?

Answer: As of today, I wouldn't say what the addition was, I wouldn't say a single thing.

Candidates for the position of chairperson of the VGTU SR CIF answer the questions that arise.

Kotryna Grumblytė KIF24/1: How do you envision cooperation with other universities?

Answer: As I mentioned, we want to improve our communication skills. We always want to have many acquaintances and communicate with other universities and student representatives. As far as I know, not everyone has this, so it would be nice to organize joint team-building meetings and gatherings to make friends at other universities.

Adding to the question: Is this with the university, or with SR?

Answer: With SR, yes.

Miglė Česonytė PKF-22/2: Have you done any analysis of what the previous team did with the representatives, and what do you mean by saying "better" in terms of what specifically you want to achieve in this area?

Answer: It's just about improvement, but perhaps not everyone is willing to talk about it. That's why the idea is to talk to them a lot during meetings, where they can share information from their academic groups.



Saulius Paukštė (guest, TSRV): Can you tell me why there are two marketing coordinators and two human resources coordinators, but only one social and academic affair coordinator and one vice-chairperson, and no one from international students affairs?

Answer: Yes, I have two marketing coordinators because they will do a much better job than one person. This will make it easier to find sponsors and everything else. Then two human resources coordinators, because when I was learning to be a chairperson, there were always two people. We haven't found a competent person to take over the duties of the international students affairs coordinator yet, so my social and academic affair coordinator Evilija. She will take over the duties for now, and if she sees that there is too much work, the team will take over.

Adding to the question: Don't you think it would be better to find the right person for the job as soon as possible?

Answer: That's what the rest of the team is for.

Agnė Dazulėnaitė (guest): Do you and your team participate in central office training program?

Answer: Yes, as far as I understand, we are currently participating.

Adding to the question: Is your team participating?

Answer: New team yes, registration is done.

Saulius Paukštė (guest, TSRV): What is the main problem in the faculty and what could you solve during this semester?

Answer: Personally speaking, from an academic point of view, there is a problem with the lecturers. People come and say something about one lecturer or another. I also see a



problem with the schedules. Since there are so many opportunities on the creative side, it becomes more difficult to coordinate with the schedules, because there are also working students and students doing internships.

Kipras Petraitis (guest): Why did you submit your presentation only in Lithuanian, compared to other faculties that did both Lithuanian and English?

Answer: Yes, I discussed this with the previous team, but there was no need for it. Although we were thinking about how we would like to attract international students, as we currently have very few or none at all in our faculty.

Miglė Česonytė PKF-22/2: You mentioned something about schedules. Does that mean we'll have to attend lectures in the evenings?

Answer: Certainly not, but perhaps there is a possibility to reduce the attendance rate for practical works or lectures by a certain percentage.

Adding to the question: Not about attendance, but about schedules.

Answer: It is difficult to agree on Interim examination, so you can negotiate with lecturers to take this into account.

Akvilė Šimanskaitė KIF-22/4: What are the three key qualities of a good leader that you could apply to yourself?

Answer: I think it's responsibility, sincerity, and openness, because I will need to work with a team, not alone.

Justas Grigalskis (guest): What would be the basis for your motivation?

Answer: As well as these aspects of my leadership: self-confidence and sincerity.



Saulius Paukštė (guest, TSRV): When it comes to openness and sincerity, what was most lacking in the previous team?

Answer: I really didn't try to talk about what happened in the previous term; I'm trying to look to the future.

Adding to the question: But honestly, can you think of what was missing the most?

Answer: Perhaps he didn't do everything he wanted to because he simply didn't have the time.

Gabrielė Nareckaitė KIF-22/1: Do you think international students should approach you, or should you approach them?

Answer: I think that I should do that.

Saulius Paukštė (guest, TSRV): As a team, do you have at least one idea on how to approach international students?

Answer: Since we only had one meeting with the team, we want to improve this. Therefore, we hope to come up with some good ideas.
