1. Registration

2. Opening of the Conference

8. Question Session

Chairperson of the VILNIUS TECH SR BMF, Vytautas Jasiulionis, answers questions regarding the VILNIUS TECH SR BMF Activity Report for the 2025 m. October 7 d. – 2026 m. February 4 d. period.

Martynas Šimkus (VPVF-22): In the first subpoint of the first point, you said that participation in protests improves social and academic processes at the university, so maybe you could comment on how exactly this happens, since it falls under that strategy point.

Answer: So, this probably falls under the social processes of the university, because just by showing that we care and just by being there, we show the university and everyone that we care about the ongoing events, and that, I think, automatically improves the social processes in our university, because we are a part of our university community.

Aistis Kviklys (OVf-24): I wanted to ask how those scholarships you mentioned were distributed.

Answer: As I mentioned, 5 bachelor degree students and 4 masters degree students got the scholarships, so me and the vice-dean looked over the overall grades of the people and the people who didn't get a scholarship but were like one step below getting it, with the highest marks, those people got one time scholarships.

Ervin Borkovski (VILNIUS TECH Students' Representation President): So I would have a question concerning your first goal's first subgoal, you mentioned participation in recent protests and you mentioned that the student representation and business management faculty showed its position while participating in such protests, so what is the position?

Answer: The position of our faculty and our deans is that we do not approve of the decisions that were made by the politicians in our government.

Saulius Paukštė (LSS): In 2.3 subpoint you mentioned that you didn't really find any long term social partners. Why did you think that was the case? How hard did you look for it?

Answer: We shouldn't hide the fact that we didn't put our priorities in that. We should have done that but we did get short term partners for our events. The main reason is

probably that a big part of our working period was for getting used to things. So that thought was swept under the rug and that is why we didn't really put all of our efforts into finding long term social partners.

Additional question: If you were to be elected, would this be one of your priorities?

Answer: Yes, that would be a priority.

Martynas Šimkus (VPVF-22): What is your one main thing you did during the period since you were elected?

Answer: I think that a big part of the period was used for landing on our feet. Just getting into the flow of things was a big job. I can confidently say that as a team we are in way stronger position than before. So that is a big thing that we did as a team. And I think it is the most important thing for now.

Ervin Borkovki (VILNIUS TECH Students' Representation President): You mentioned that your HR's did 1on1's. What was the main thing that you talked about and what areas your team members need to work on to be better?

Answer: One thing that we all lack is communication. A big part of our team and I as well had a hard time communicating properly. So the biggest one is communication. Also a personal thing that I noticed was that I speak too professionally with my team and I should be more casual.

Additional question: For the past few years I heard that the main problem in Student Representation was a toxic environment. So has it changed in the last four months?

Answer: Of course it isn't perfect but we definitely improved comparing the start to now and intend to keep on improving.

Ervin Borkovski (VILNIUS TECH Students' Representation President): I have a question concerning values. Do you place your Student Representation faculty needs above the needs of the whole organization?

Answer: I can confidently say that we have to take care of our University and not our faculty. Of course the day to day goals fall under our faculty because we want to make it better but the priority is still our whole University.

13. Question session

The candidates for the position of VILNIUS TECH SR BMF Chairperson answered the questions raised.

Martynas Šimkus (VPVF-22): Why didn't you put finding social partners as your goal into the slides?

Answer: I didn't put that into my slides because it is a goal that already should be in progress.

Saulius Paukštė (LSS): You mentioned that you have less student involvement in Student Representation. Do you have any numbers like how many members do you have now? Or how many members did you have a year ago maybe? And how do you plan to improve the students' involvement?

Answer: I do not have the exact numbers but the fact of the matter is that it's not about the amount of members that we have, it's about their motivation and activity. We as a team decided that we will continue to work by giving a chance for our members to participate in our committees and of course the informal events but that is a small part of that.

Martynas Šimkus (VPVF-22): You said that strategic partners are something that should be pursued anyway, but why did you write those four goals as well if they also should be pursued and were already written by at least four chairpersons before you?

Answer: Finding the social partners is definitely one of those goals but our main priority is students and our community so the social partners part is what I decided not to show.

Additional question: Which of the goals that you have in your slides are for students?

Atsakymas: Well the first goal of ensuring efficiency and continuity of current activities is when you ensure the efficiency and continuity of current activities in our Students Representation you automatically help students.

16. Question session

The candidates for the position of VILNIUS TECH SR President answered the questions raised.

Martynas Šimkus (VPVF-22): Since you are in your second year and are quite a young member of the student representation, I wanted to ask what you plan to do to fill your competency gaps so that you can represent students strongly and effectively at the university-wide level.

Answer: Thank you for your question. First of all, I would work on improving my competence as much as possible. Currently, I registered for LSS, so I registered for mentorship, and hopefully I will increase my competences there.

Martynas Šimkus (VPVF-22): You have a lot of goals in your presentation. How many of them are you planning to accomplish during your one-year term?

Answer: Yes, I have thought about that. Most of my goals have already been started and were initiated during the last term, so it will be easier to accomplish them during my one-year term.

Additional question: Which one would you like to be accomplished first or during your term, not by others in the future but during your term? Which of the goals looks the most important?

Answer: I would say the newsletter initiative, because I would really like more students to join the student representation, as it is a great place to develop your skills and learn. I would also say reviewing every study program to improve them as much as possible, so that students can study more freely and in better conditions.

Justas Grigalskis (ECf-24): In your guidelines, you mention the project of increasing the prestige of class representatives and, in general, checking and strengthening their motivation. So practically speaking, how do you plan to motivate class representatives so that their role is not just a formality? As a vice-chairman, I can say that we are currently facing demotivated class representatives ourselves and are struggling with this issue. That is why I am interested in how you plan to address this problem.

Answers: Thank you for your question. I do not have a specific plan yet, but I do have an idea to work more closely with student mentors and improve how they present the responsibilities of representatives. We already have a student representatives' prestige project in progress, so I would try to further develop and improve that project.

Saulius Paukšte (LSS): You mentioned a newsletter initiative. How often would it be sent out — weekly, monthly?

Answer: I would say twice a month is enough, because we have not started this project yet, so I cannot tell you for sure how often it should be sent. For now, I believe twice a month is enough. What will happen in the future will happen in the future.

Additional question: And would the content there involve representation-wide decisions, or maybe faculty too?

Answer: I would say faculty would also be included.

Martynas Šimkus (VPVF-22): I wanted to ask you specifically about the labour market analysis you mentioned, about checking whether our study programmes are relevant. I wanted to ask if you have looked into whether our university already does this. I mean, when they update the study programmes, do the programme committees that meet and involve labour market experts not already do this kind of analysis? Or is this something that is not actually being done?

Answer: So I think it is necessary to look into a job analysis, and because I had little time to prepare for everything, I am not 100 percent confident in everything I know about the job market analysis and what the university is doing, but I will look into it. I do believe that even though the university may already be doing a job analysis and working on that, it is safer for us to look into it ourselves as student representatives.

Additional question: How would you implement your analysis into the study committee and the study programmes, and what would be your main moves and steps?

Answer: So first of all, I would like to look into the job analysis and do that analysis, but further on I would say that this is a job for the whole team, so we will talk about it and decide what steps we have to take.

Justas Grigalskis (ECf-24): You mentioned covering the LSIC card fee, which was actually also raised during the previous cadency. So what are you planning to do differently to make sure this would actually happen?

Answer: Thank you for your question. So currently, I know that students who are living in dormitories have their own cards, like white cards. I would like to make the LSIC card more widely used so that students could also access dormitories with it, instead of having another card – one card would be used for everything. So I would start with that. I would also communicate with the university administration and talk about it.
